**A RESOLUTION REGARDING AN AGREEMENT WITH BDO USA, LLP FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROCURING NIGC-MICS COMPLIANCE SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Tunica-Biloxi Gaming Authority, d/b/a Paragon Casino Resort (“the Authority” or “the Enterprise”), desires to enter into an agreement with BDO USA, LLP (“BDO”) for services, as set forth in the agreement to provide services from BDO dated October 5, 2018 and pertaining to Compliance with the National Indian Gaming Commission Minimum Internal Control Standards (referred herein as “BDO NIGC-MICS Agreement”). The Authority hereby consents to and authorizes a limited waiver of sovereign immunity in favor of Mediation and Arbitration when suit is brought by the Authority/ the Enterprise against BDO only.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That the Authority enter into the BDO NIGC-MICS Agreement with BDO for the purpose of procuring services for NIGC compliance.


Section 2. That the Authority hereby expressly grants a limited waiver of sovereign immunity in favor Mediation and Arbitration when suit is brought by the Authority / the Enterprise against BDO as set forth in page 4 of the BDO NIGC-MICS Agreement and Section 8 of the *Addendum to Agreement Between Tunica-Biloxi Gaming Authority and BDO USA, LLP*
