Job Title: Director of Construction Services

Summary:

The Director of Construction Services will be responsible for developing and managing the Tunica-Biloxi Industries Tribal 8(a) Federal Construction portfolio. The Director will provide leadership, oversight, and overall responsibility for the timeliness, completeness, quality, cost and profitability of multiple construction projects, with a focus on larger and/or more complex projects in the commercial and federal sectors. This role involves comprehensive project management, collaboration with key stakeholders, and ensuring strict compliance with all relevant laws and regulations. Experience with Entity Owned Firms (ANC, AIT, HNO) is required. The Director of Construction Services will also be a pivotal component for core market sustainment and new business growth, new business opportunity identification, qualification, competitive positioning, and capture.

Responsibilities:

- Provide overall leadership, support, and management for assigned construction projects, from concept through completion.
- Lead or participate in project initiation meetings, progress meetings, and other relevant discussions to review scopes of work, special requirements, schedules, and budgets. Adherence to the schedule is most critical.
- Lead the estimating stage of a project to ensure that the required costs are covered.
- Responsible for the delivery and execution of the cost and profit forecast for each project. Understand variances and develop plans to mitigate.
- Utilize construction management systems and methodologies as defined by the company to ensure project success.
- Lead in Developing the Scope of Services for a Construction bid package, based on available Engineering documents, material take-offs, etc.
- Ensure the timeliness, completeness, quality, and cost-effectiveness of projects.
- Establish and maintain positive and effective relationships with key contacts to develop business opportunities and ensure excellent customer service.
- Oversee and manage Architects, Contractors, Subcontractors, Construction Managers, and project administrative staff to ensure their responsibilities are met.

- Collaborate with project stakeholders to coordinate and optimize the allocation of resources, including labor, materials, and equipment.
- Ensure all projects are administered in compliance with relevant laws and regulations, including those related to safety, labor relations, and EEOC.
- Supervise and manage all contract requirements, including submittals, payment applications, schedules, and budgets.
- Provide regular updates to senior management on project progress, financial status, and client satisfaction.
- Attend or lead business meetings representing the company at government agencies, adhering to professional business attire requirements.
- Monitor project timelines, identifying potential delays, and implementing corrective measures to ensure timely completion.
- Implement and oversee safety protocols, ensuring compliance with health, safety, and environmental regulations. Prioritize and enhance the safety of the work environment.
- Effectively manage change orders, evaluating their impact on construction projects and ensuring proper documentation and communication.
- Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

Education/Experience:

- Ability to manage multiple simultaneous construction projects in various phases.
- Ten plus years (5+) years of related construction experience with an emphasis in federal construction, along with a broad construction and managerial background, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A bachelor's degree in engineering or construction management
- Must have effective oral and written communication skills coupled with the ability to establish and maintain productive customer and industry participant networks.
- Familiarity with the capture of Entity owned 8(a) and IEDC set aside new business capture and opportunities would be a plus.
- Working knowledge of contract, federal, and municipal laws related to the federal government (FAR/ITAR, etc.).
- OSHA Safety training a plus (10 or 30 hour)
- PMP or DBIA certification preferred.

• Must be a US citizen with ability to obtain and maintain Government security clearance.

Preference:

- Tier 4 A spouse, parent, or child of an enrolled member of other federal or state recognized Tribes who meet the qualification of the job description.
- Tier 5-All other applicants who meet the qualification of the job description.
