# **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:**

### October-December 2020

#### **Social Services**

Services are available for individuals who are in need of community referrals, assistance with child abuse/neglect cases, domestic violence cases, and/or family preservation needs.

### **Healthy Transitions**

Provides mental health services & treatment options along with prevention activities for youth and young adults ages 16-25.

### **Voc Rehab Program**

The VR Program services enrolled tribal members 16 and older who have a diagnosed disability in finding employment or pursuing educational goals.

Items are available for individuals needing assistance. Program is limited to ONCE a month per family.

# E-Covid Response

Emergency Covid-19 Program provides mental health assistance to individuals who struggle with depression, anxiety, trauma and grief related to Covid-19.

**Victim Services** 

This program provides services to victims of

sexual assault, domestic violence, elder abuse,

human trafficking and family violence.

### Tribal Behavioral Health

Provides mental health and substance use-related treatment options for young adults under the age of 24 along with community awareness and training.

## **Transportation**

Available for individuals 55 & older and/or individuals who do not have valid transportation. Transportation to/from doctor, basic living needs etc.

### Juvenile Healing to Wellness Court

Program focuses upon tribal at-risk youth who have become involved within the criminal justice system.

### Tribal Opioid Response

Prevention activities/curriculum classes for tribal youth in regard to Opioid usage.
