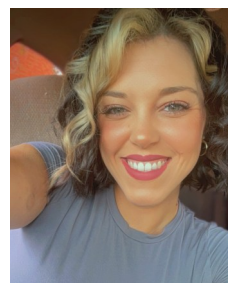

Parent Learning Corner: Need ideas for summer? Need new and interesting ways to encourage your kids to learn? How about your own backyard?

Ways to Bring Technology into Your Backyard Learning:

Parents and educators who integrate outdoor STEM activities into regular playtime help children develop a stronger foundation in science and mathematics. The natural world can provide endless opportunities for children to explore, experiment, and discover **STEM concepts** through hands-on experiences. Children exploring STEM concepts outdoors have shown remarkable improvements in their critical thinking and cognitive abilities.

So, how can you get started?

- Encourage your kid(s) to write all their outdoor STEM explorations in a journal; write their observations, ask questions, and form hypotheses. This practice reinforces the scientific thinking skills needed for school, and they connect with nature, creating a love for science.
- Help them build a DIY weather station.
- Have them plant seeds and conduct plant growth experiments. What do they need to grow?

- Help them explore playground equipment and see that they are actually simple machines!
- Help them examine the water flow in a stream. This is physics!

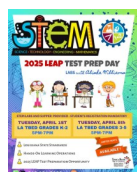

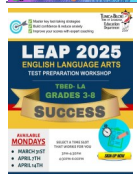

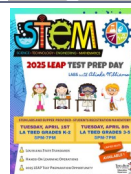
